Dear Commissioner,

I would like to express my appreciation for your initial concern with regard to yesterday's

calamity that befell the Region of Attiki whereby more than 60 people lost their lives, hundreds

were injured and thousands were left homeless due to major wildfires that broke out in two

locations, in the western and eastern parts of the Region which were declared in a state of

emergency.

The blazes, fuelled by gale-force winds exceeding 100 km/h, were impossible to contain by the

combined efforts of the civil protection mechanism services and went on consuming forests,

property, networks and lives along their path. As you are well aware, in order to anticipate the

disaster, we requested the activation of the Union's Civil Protection Mechanism.

In the aftermath of the destruction and as damage assessments are already underway, we

estimate the economic impact of the disaster to be of great significance, especially now that the

country is recovering from a protracted economic crisis and the sustainability of its public

finances is at a crucial point.
